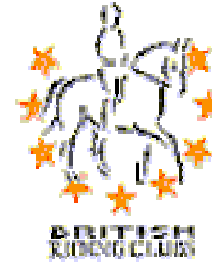
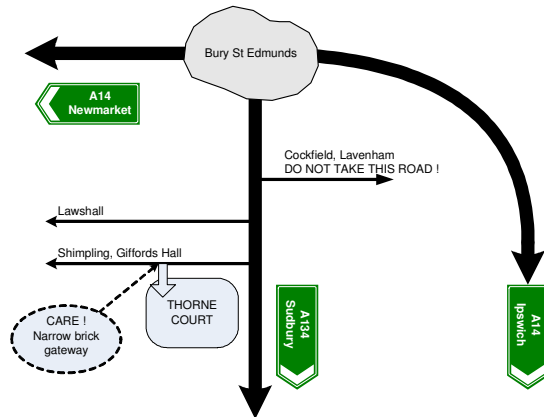


RULES AND CONDITIONS

HORSES & PONIES must be 4 years & over unless classes specify
HEALTH & SAFETY The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and obey the instructions of the Organiser and all Officials and Stewards.
LIABILITY The Owners/Organisers will not accept any responsibility for any accident injury illness or loss of property howsoever caused
HARD HATS to BSI standard PAS 015 –En 1384 or ASTM F1163 must be worn at all times whilst mounted with chin strap or harness in place.
CORRECT FOOTWEAR must be worn when mounted.
DOGS must be kept on leads at all times
CHILDREN & PUSHCHAIRS must be kept away from practice areas and collecting rings.
DECLARATION all competitors **MUST** declare to secretary on arrival
VACCINATION CERTIFICATES It is expected that all equines brought onto the showground have current vaccination certificates for equine influenza.
REFUNDS for entry fees only refunded on production of a valid vet or doctor's certificate.
OBJECTIONS must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the end of the class with a £10.00 deposit, which will be forfeit if the objection is over-ruled.
RESERVATION The organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if deemed necessary and to refuse an entry without having to state the reason.

JUMPING MAY HAVE TO TAKE PLACE BETWEEN DRESSAGE TESTS

- CLASS 1a PRELIMINARY DRESSAGE TEST NO 12 2005
CLASS 1b With JUMPING, fences not exceeding 2'0". Open
- CLASS 2a PRELIMINARY DRESSAGE TEST NO 14 2006
CLASS 2b With JUMPING, fences not exceeding 2'6". Open
- CLASS 3a NOVICE DRESSAGE TEST NO 24 2010
CLASS 3b With JUMPING, fences up to 2'6". Open.
- CLASS 4a NOVICE DRESSAGE TEST NO 28 2008
or
CLASS 4b NOVICE DRESSAGE TEST NO 34 2006
CLASS 4c Either test with JUMPING, fences up to 2'9". Open
Class judged as one, highest percentage to win
- CLASS 5a ELEMENTARY DRESSAGE TEST NO 45 2010
or
CLASS 5b MEDIUM TEST NO 61 2002
CLASS 5c Either test with JUMPING fences not exceeding 3'0" . Open.
Class judged as one, highest percentage to win
- CLASS 6 RIDING CLUB RIDING TESTS
SECTION A RIDING TEST NO 11 (2010) Riders under 17 yrs
SECTION B RIDING TEST NO 11(2010) Senior Novice
SECTION C RIDING TEST NO 13 (2010) Senior riders
Rosettes to highest percentage over all sections
Sections will be divided if entries warrant.
Judged on rider's position in the saddle and ability to influence the horse's way of going
- CLASS 7 RIDING CLUB STYLE JUMPING TEST. 2010
Fences approx 2'6" to 2'9" Riders any age, will be divided at 17yrs if entries warrant. Judged on the rider's position & fluency of the jumping round. Snaffle bridles. Riders using martingales on their horses may compete hors concors. Speed 350m/minute
- CLASS 8 RURAL RIDERS 2006 - Open to teams of 6 horses and 6 senior riders

ENTRY FEES TO INCLUDE FIRST AID:

PER CLASS £6.00 Dressage, Riding Test, or Style jumping (£5.00 members)
£10.00 Dressage with jumping (£9.00 members)
Competitors entering the 'b' classes for Classes 1-3 will automatically be entered in the 'a' class and ride the test only once. Competitors entering Classes 4c or 5c must specify which test they will ride and will be entered automatically into that class, riding the test only once.
Members must be registered by 1st April 2010

ROSETTES to the first six in each class, and a special rosette to the highest placed registered pure or part-bred Connemara in all Dressage and Dressage with jumping classes. Registration information must be declared on the entry form.

The Cutter Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the best Junior Members performance on the day, and the Croxton Portia Trophy will be awarded for the best Senior Members performance. The 'A Breeze' Memorial Challenge Trophy kindly donated by Mr Shaun Wynne-Rogerson will be awarded at the end of the year for the member gaining the most points in all Dressage competitions during the year.

JUDGING SHEETS will be available 20 mins after the Class results have been posted unless a judge is officiating for more than one class. Please leave SAE for sheets to be forwarded if not remaining on the Showground to the appropriate time.

RIDING TEST SHEETS will be available from the secretary, please add cost of 40p per sheet to your entry fee & enclose an SAE

THE SHOW WILL BE RUN UNDER BHS RIDING CLUB RULES
and British Dressage Rules may also apply.
