

## RULES AND CONDITIONS

**HORSES & PONIES** must be 4 years & over unless classes specify

**HEALTH & SAFETY** The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and obey the instructions of the Organiser and all Officials and Stewards.

**LIABILITY** The Owners/Organisers will not accept any responsibility for any accident injury illness or loss of property howsoever caused

**HARD HATS** to BSI standard PAS 015 -En 1384 or ASTM F1163 must be worn at all times whilst mounted with chin strap or harness in place.

**CORRECT FOOTWEAR** must be worn when mounted.

**DOGS** must be kept on leads at all times

**CHILDREN & PUSHCHAIRS** must be kept away from practice areas and collecting rings.

**DECLARATION** all competitors **MUST** declare to secretary on arrival

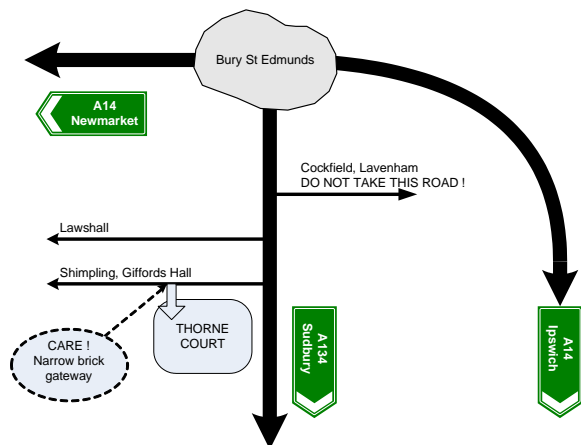
**VACCINATION CERTIFICATES** It is expected that all equines brought onto the showground have current vaccination certificates for equine influenza.

**ENTRY FEES TO INCLUDE FIRST AID:**

PER CLASS £6.00 Dressage, (£5.00 members)

Members must be registered by 1<sup>st</sup> April 2011

Competitors entering Class 8 must specify which test they will ride.

**ROSETTES** to the first six in each class,.

The 'A Breeze' Memorial Challenge Trophy kindly donated by Mr Shaun Wynne-Rogerson will be awarded at the end of the year for the member gaining the most points in all Dressage competitions during the year.

**NPS/TopSpec Supreme Dressage Championships 2012**

The competition will be judged by British Dressage Judges using British Dressage Tests Prelim 14 & Novice 28 throughout. The two highest placed ponies in each section at each qualifying show will qualify for the 2012 Final.

Sections are open to:-

1. Registered Mountain & Moorland breeds not exceeding 138cm
  2. Registered Mountain & Moorland breeds exceeding 138cm
  3. Registered British Riding Ponies
  4. Part Bred Horses/Ponies registered with their appropriate Native Breed Part Bred Stud Book
  5. Highest placed rider aged under 12 years on 1st January 2010
- \* Part Bred Native ponies over-stamped within the British Riding Pony Stud Book may only compete in one section per season.

Qualifying rounds will be open to everyone from across the UK.

All qualifiers will receive Sponsors rosettes and cards.

Horse/ponies must be ridden at the Final by the qualifying rider.

Those qualifying for the Final must be fully paid up Dressage or Showing members of the NPS for 2012 in order to compete at the 2012 NPS/TopSpec Final.

**JUDGING SHEETS** will be available 20 mins after the Class results have been posted unless a judge is officiating for more than one class. Please leave SAE for sheets to be forwarded if not remaining on the Showground to the appropriate time.

THE SHOW WILL BE RUN UNDER BHS RIDING CLUB RULES  
and British Dressage Rules may also apply.
