

NOTES

The event will be run under Riding Club Rules and Medical Armbands must be worn during Cross Country

Dressage Tests may not be commanded

Dressage Sheets will be available soon after the dressage phase is completed.

It is the responsibility of the competitor to have the correct equipment for horse & rider.

The speed for the Cross Country Phase will be:-

3'3" course 475mpm, 2'9" course 450mpm, 2'3" course 425mpm

Horses & Ponies must be ridden at walk except in designated practice areas and on the course.

There is no deposit for Cross Country numbers but it is expected that they are returned in good condition and untied. **They must be worn in all 3 phases of the competition.**

RULES AND CONDITIONS

HORSES & PONIES must be 5 years & over unless classes specify

HEALTH & SAFETY The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and obey the instructions of the Organiser and all Officials and Stewards.

LIABILITY The Owners/Organisers will not accept any responsibility for any accident injury illness or loss of property howsoever caused

HARD HATS to BSI standard PAS 015-En 1384 or ASTM F1163 must be worn at all times whilst mounted with chin strap or harness in place.

CORRECT FOOTWEAR must be worn when mounted.

DOGS must be kept on short, fixed leads at all times

CHILDREN & PUSHCHAIRS must be kept away from practice areas and collecting rings. **CHILDREN** must be fully supervised when walking on the Cross Country Course at all times before and during the event

VACCINATION CERTIFICATES It is expected that all equines brought onto the showground have current vaccination certificates for equine influenza.

REFUNDS for entry fees only refunded on production of a valid vet or doctor's certificate.

OBJECTIONS must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the end of the class with a £10.00 deposit, which will be forfeit if the objection is over-ruled.

RESERVATION The organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if deemed necessary and to refuse an entry without having to state the reason.

PLEASE NOTE - LEVEL 3 BODY PROTECTORS & MEDICAL ARMBANDS MUST BE WORN DURING ALL CROSS COUNTRY ROUNDS

- CLASS 1** Open One Day Event – Open to any horse/pony, rider any age
 Phase A Dressage – BE 100 Test 102
 Phase B Show Jumping – jumps approx 3'3" (1m)
 Phase C Cross Country – jumps approx 3'3" (1m)
- CLASS 2** Small Open One Day Event – open to any horse/pony, rider any age
 Phase A Dressage – BE 90 Test 92
 Phase B Show Jumping – jumps approx 2'9" (89cms)
 Phase C Cross Country – jumps approx 2'9" (89cms)
- CLASS 3** Restricted Novice One Day Event
 Phase A Dressage – BD Prelim Test No 13
 Phase B Show Jumping – jumps approx 2'9" (89cms)
 Phase C Cross Country – jumps approx 2'9" (89cms)
 There will be a junior section (Rider under 17yrs on 1st January 2010) in the class if entries warrant. Combination must not have been placed 1st in any One Day Event, at this height or above.
- CLASS 4** Beginners One Day Event – Rider 17yrs & over
 Phase A Dressage – BD Prelim Test No 7
 Phase B Show Jumping – jumps approx 2'3" (69cms)
 Phase C Cross Country – jumps approx 2'3" (69cms)
- CLASS 5** Beginners One Day Event – Rider under 17yrs on 1st January 2010
 Phase A Dressage – BD Prelim Test No 7
 Phase B Show Jumping – jumps approx 2'3" (69cms)
 Phase C Cross Country – jumps approx 2'3" (69cms)
- Restriction for Classes 4 & 5 – combination of horse/pony and rider not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any One Day Event with fences over 70cms

Horse/Ponies may only be entered in one of the above event classes.

ENTRY FEES – all entries must be on an official entry form

Event classes – £25 per entry, £18 SERC members paid up by close of entries. Late entries if accepted £30. All entry fees include veterinary and first aid cover. Refunds after close of entries only on production of vet/doctor certificate.

ALL TIMES will be sent out by post, please enclose a **1st class self-seal SAE** with your entry form.

ROSETTES to 8th place in all dressage and event classes where entries permit. Special Rosette for Best Connemara Performance
