HORSES & PONIES must be 4 years & over unless classes specify

HARD HATS to BSI standard PAS 015 –En 1384 or ASTM F1163 must be worn at all times whilst mounted with chin strap or harness in place.

DOGS must be kept on short, non-extending leads at all times

CHILDREN & PUSHCHAIRS must be kept away from practice areas and collecting rings.

VACCINATION CERTIFICATES It is expected that all equines brought onto the showground have current vaccination certificates for equine influenza.

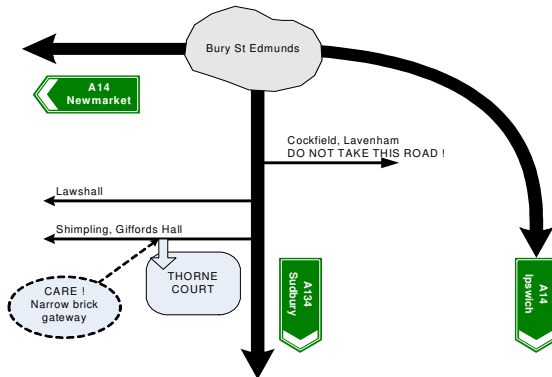
REFUNDS entry fees only refunded on production of a valid vet or doctor's certificate.

OBJECTIONS must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the end of the class with a £10.00 deposit, which will be forfeit if the objection is over-ruled.

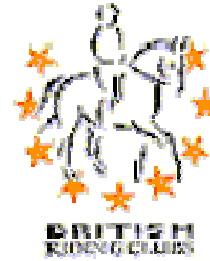
RESERVATION The organisers reserve the right to cancel any class if deemed necessary and to refuse an entry without having to state the reason.

RING 1 TO COMMENCE AT 10AM

JUDGE - Wayne Bailey

- CLASS 1 WORKING HUNTER PONY UP TO 13.2hh Fences 2' max, rider any age.
CLASS 2 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY UP TO 15.0hh Fences 2'3" max, rider any age, combination not to have been placed 1st in this height or above in any WHP class
CLASS 3 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER 15.0hh & OVER. Fences 2'6" max, rider any age, combination not to have been placed 1st in this height or above in any WH class
CLASS 4 OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY UP TO 15hh Fences 2'9" max, rider any age
CLASS 5 OPEN WORKING HUNTER 15.0hh & OVER. Fences 3' max, rider any age.
All 1st and 2nd places from Classes 1-5 to go forward into a Championship
CLASS 6 RIDDEN HUNTER – this class may be split by weight if entries warrant and at the judges discretion.

RING 2 TO COMMENCE AT 10.30AM

JUDGE - Yvonne Bowen

- CLASS 7 RIDING CLUB HORSE - over 14.2hh, rider any age. To be judged 20% turnout, 35% basic paces, 25% manners, 20% jumping ability and fluency.
CLASS 8 FAMILY MOUNT – any height, rider any age. To be judged 20% turnout, 40% suitability for family, 40% Manners. Class may be split by height at the judges discretion if entries warrant.
CLASS 9 PONY CLUB PONY 14.2hh & under, rider 16 years & under to include

MARRIAGE'S RIDING CLUB PONY OF THE YEAR

For ponies 14.2hh and under, 4 years and over, riders 16 years and under. To be judged on suitability for all riding/pony club activities. Will be required to jump. To be ridden in a snaffle bridle only, hanging cheek snaffles are permitted but no wilkie or loop ring bits are allowed. Spurs may not be worn, whips/canes not to exceed 30" (75cms). Breastplates & cruppers are allowed. NO martingales, running reins, draw reins, grass reins or lead reins are allowed.

THIS IS A QUALIFYING COMPETITION. THE FIRST THREE PONIES GO FOWARD TO THE SUFFOLK FINAL ON SUNDAY 25TH SEPTEMBER 2011 AT NEWTON HALL EQUESTRIAN CENTRE, THREE OR LESS PONIES FOWARD ON THE DAY, ONLY THE FIRST PLACED PONY WILL QUALIFY.

RING 2 NOT TO COMMENCE BEFORE 1.30PM

- CLASS 10 LEAD REIN SHOWING – Judged on suitability and manners of pony for lead rein - combination not to be entered in any other class off the Lead Rein.

- CLASS 11 FIRST RIDDEN – Ponies 12.0hh and under – judged on suitability for the rider, riders to be 10 years & under
CLASS 12 RIDDEN COLOURED/SPOTTED HORSE – Open to all types breeds, sizes & sex, rider any age. To be judged 60% conformation & presence, 40% manners & ride. Lead Rein permitted
CLASS 13 VETERAN EQUINES – 17 YEARS & OVER - RIDDEN, any height, breed or sex. Lead Rein permitted

- CLASS 14 IN HAND SHOWING - 3 years & under – any breed
CLASS 15 IN HAND SHOWING MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND – Small Breeds, any age
CLASS 16 IN HAND SHOWING MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND – Large Breeds, any age
CLASS 17 IN HAND SHOWING EX-RACERS – see class 9 for details
CLASS 18 LEAD REIN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND Rider any age. Combination not to be entered in any other class off the Lead Rein.
CLASS 19 RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND – Small Breeds, rider any age
CLASS 20 RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND – Large Breeds, rider any age
CLASS 21 RIDDEN NOVICE EX-RACERS club showing class for ex-racehorses. All horses to be registered with the Ex Racers Club before entry. Registration forms can be found at www.exracersclub.com .
